Word typically allows you to choose whether to position the gutter margin of your document at the top or left of the page; if you have previously set your document to the "mirror margins," "book fold" or "two pages per sheet" layout options, Word will automatically set the gutter margins to a position that matches the chosen layout.

The "gutter" of a bound document such as a book is the area where the page disappears into the binding. If you specify a gutter measurement in the Page Setupdialog, this amount will be applied to the margin on Note that you have a choice of Leftand Top.

Margins for Bound Documents

Every page has three outside margins (top, bottom, and side) and one inside margin (also called the gutter). Margins ensure your text isn't cut off during manufacturing. Set your page size before you set your margins.

On the File menu, click Page Setup, and then click the Margins tab. In the Gutter box, enter a value for the gutter margin. In the Gutter position box, click Left, or Top. You should click Left, if you plan to bind the document at the left or right side or click Top, if you plan to bind the document at the top side.
